

## REBECCA SMITH LECTURE AND WORKSHOP

### Lecture: Tapestry Interpretations of Ancient Imagery, October 9

Seers and healers of the ancient world immortalized their spiritual visions by etching images onto the surface of rocks. This visually inspiring presentation explores rock art imagery from sites in the Southwest United States. Rebecca has woven tapestries based on rock art, or petroglyphs, for the past decade. She will illustrate how she has interpreted the imagery through tapestry and bead weaving.

### Workshop: Weave a Kachina or Spirit Doll, October 10

This workshop gives students the opportunity to create a personal weaving experience inspired by ancient rock art. Students will choose an image to portray through simple weft-faced weaving using a mix of yarns. The woven images will be embellished with beads and feathers.
